Competition for International and National schools

1. Snapshot (Photo Editing)

Teams per school: Open

Participant(s) per team: 2

Software: Adobe Photoshop or any other free image editing software

Classes: Open

Topic: World Water Day / International day of yoga

Participants are required to edit, combine and/or create images and build a final composition based on a topic.

- a) Students must submit their creations (.psd/.jpg/.png) to "geekahertz.sms@gmail.com" along with participant's details.
- b) Subject line must be "**Country_snapshot_schoolname**" and file name must be "**school name.**" The file must contain the participation details.
- c) Last date for the Final Submission will be **10th November' 2019**

2. Game /Story (Software – Scratch)
